Preservation - Tristahn Schaub and team

- CC&R Legal Opinions Ian Quinn
 - Supreme Court of AZ Amending CC&Rs came out last week. The opinion came about b/c of case in Tucson. The case is a strong signal that courts will not enforce amendments to CC&Rs that could not have been anticipated by the language of the original document. For example, short-term rentals were not a thing when nearly all of the Arcadia CC&R documents were written. Therefore, it will be very difficult to amend those documents to include prohibitions on short-term rentals.
 - The original Intent of the CC&R's is all the Supreme Court wants to enforce
 - As much as CC&R's might be a tool, the legislation might not enforce what current neighbors want.
 - Some documents (w/ supermajority) might be able to tear up and start over
- CCC Digital Sign legal action <u>Tristahn Schaub</u>
 - Last Board Mtg, ACMNA voted to appeal the decision. We filed a complaint and need to decide if we're going forward and how much money willing to spend.
 - <u>Marvin B</u>. shared ACMNA's mission and argued that fighting this sign speaks to the core of our mission.
 - The largest expense for ACMNA is legal fees.
 - We have 45 days to serve
