Preservation

- Camelback Church of Christ 4x8' Digital Display BOA- <u>Tristahn</u> postponed to 2/3
- 5035 E Lafayette Pool House with a Kitchen the hearing is 1/20/22
 - Discussion. Determined ACMNA will oppose based on not wanting to set a precedence; although the homeowner is designing a pool house, the structure can easily be turned into a guest house or living quarters; there is no way to ensure that if/when the property is sold, the new owner would not transform the pool house into a guest house; ACMNA has been dealing with complaints about short-term rentals for years; guest houses on properties of this size and so close to neighbors would exacerbate the issue; a structure of this type creates unusual opportunities, such as connecting the structure to the main house.
 - Amanda McCauley will write ACMNA's letter of opposition to the variance

- Cholla Trail Tanks- <u>Jody</u> construction was supposed to start Jan 3 and will take until Sep 2023.
