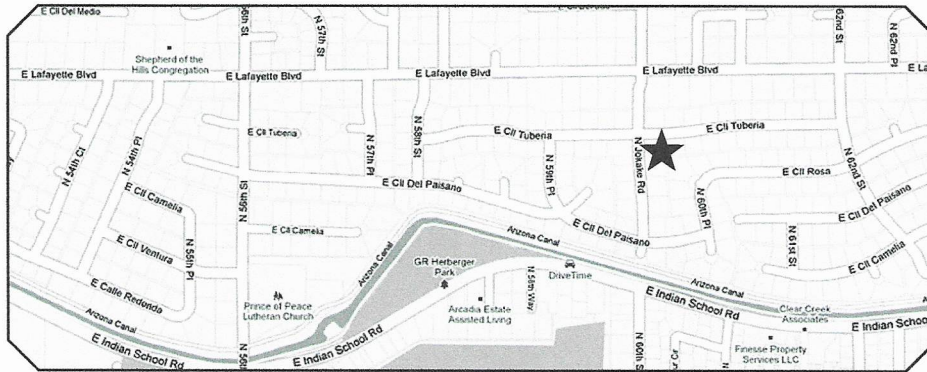


Arcadia Neighborhood

Fourth of July Parade & Potluck Breakfast

DATE: July 4th • **LOCATION:** SE corner of Jokake & Calle Tuberia
PARADE REGISTRATION: 7:30 a.m. • **PARADE START:** 8:00 a.m.



ROUTE. The parade route starts and ends at Jokake and Calle Tuberia. It heads west on Calle Tuberia to 58th Street, then south on 58th street (short block) to Calle Del Paisano, east on Calle Del Paisano, short jog to Calle Rosa, continue east to 62nd street, go north to Calle Tuberia (short blocks) then west on Calle Tuberia back to the parade start. It is about a mile for the route.

PARADE. Most participants walk or ride their bikes to the start, so there are not a lot of cars and parking except for the volunteers and sponsors. Parking is available on nearby streets. Your cooperation is greatly appreciated in keeping the parade route clear.

COME ONE, COME ALL! Bring your pets, decorated bikes, go-peds, wagons, skate boards, roller blades, trikes, baby strollers, go-carts, antique cars, floats, and YOU! The City of Phoenix Fire Department will be leading the parade again this year. We are also happy to welcome back the Scottsdale Trombone Choir as well as the American Legion Color Guard. Bottled water will be available.
