
ROAD CLOSURE NOTICE

The contractor will be performing water line rehabilitation work at the intersection of 48th Street and Thomas Road.

Beginning **September 1, 2017**, **48th Street** will be **closed** to all traffic on the north side of Thomas Road.

Residents living north of Thomas Road off of 48th Street will have to enter and exit the neighborhood utilizing the streets to the north of Thomas Road.

Traffic approaching 48th Street from the south will have to turn right (east) at Thomas Road - all left turns and will be restricted at this intersection. One lane of traffic in each direction will be maintained on Thomas Road.
